

RFP Default Management Vendor Inquiry Response Part 1

Our pricing is activity based, is it allowable to add a separate page describing our pricing model in more detail?

Yes, it is allowable to add a separate page describing your pricing model in more detail.

Will all member schools within the Community College System of New Hampshire be required to participate in all services?

All seven college within the Community College System of New Hampshire have elected to participate in all services.

Will a school be allowed to select certain default prevention services?

The services selected will be consistent across the System.

Section III Cost: This section is asking for labor and materials costs, which does not necessarily apply to the services included in this RFP. Are you expecting one lump-sum total for all services for all schools within the Community College System?

In this section, we are expecting a comprehensive summary of costs, by college, for all services outlined in the vendor's proposal.

Is there flexibility in the pricing information that can be submitted? Such as pricing based on unit costs per activity, for example.

Yes, there is flexibility in the pricing information that can be submitted provided that all costs for services detailed in the proposal are provided.

When do you anticipate starting services with the selected vendor?

Depending on when the vendor is selected and contracts are finalized, we anticipate that services would begin as early as July 1, 2019.

What is meant by the "Partial payments are allowed" statement in the "Payment & Compensation" section?

This is standard language included in all RFPs. It typically refers to payments related to one-time service contracts. In the case of this RFP, it is expected that the System would be billed for and pay for services on a monthly basis.
